
SUBJECT Utility Permits - Townships


SUBJECT      Cable - Burying

ADOPTED ON      December 11, 1996

A motion was made by Commissioner Wahoviak, and supported by Commissioner Harris, that the following policy concerning burying cable within county road right of way be adopted. Roll Call Vote: Wahoviak - aye, Harris - aye, and Erickson - aye.

An agreement shall be executed between the Dickinson County Road Commission and all utilities requesting the burying of cable within county road right of way. The agreement shall hold the Dickinson County Road Commission harmless for any and all damage. All cable must be buried three feet from the outer edge of right of way ( except for telephone cable ), that all cable must be signed, and all signs maintained by the utility company. No permit shall be issued without written approval by the township in which the work is to be done.



POLICY NO 5

SUBJECT Cable - Telephone  
ADOPTED ON December 11, 1996

A motion was made by Commissioner Wahoviak, and supported by Commissioner Harris, that the following policy concerning the burying of telephone cable be adopted.  
Roll Call Vote: Wahoviak - aye, Harris - aye, and Erickson - aye.

Telephone cable shall be buried or established in the outer ten feet of the county road right of way, as that road right of way exists at the time of installation of the telephone lines, except where the contrary is authorized by permit where special conditions exist. No permit shall be issued without written approval by the township in which the work is to be done.

**SUBJECT**              Decking on Dickinson County Roads

**ADOPTED ON**        September 8, 2015

A motion was made by Commissioner Milbrath and supported by Commissioner Brisson that it shall be the policy of the Dickinson County Road Commission as follows:

A permit be required for all decking on a County Road right-of-way. (Permit to be revocable if conditions are not adhered to.)

The Dickinson County Road Commission, its Board, employees, successors and assigns shall be named as Additional Insured on the contractor's, logger's, and truck driver's General Liability and Auto Liability insurance certificates with a \$2,000,000 per occurrence limit for each. Property insurance of up to \$2,000,000 may be required when needed.

Decking will not be allowed on County Road right-of-way in which the roadway is paved.

Decking will not be allowed on any County Road right-of-way during Seasonal Road restrictions.

Decking placement to be at the outermost portion of a County Road right-of-way and will only be allowed in special circumstances where the terrain does not allow decking off of the road and by the discretion of the Superintendent or designee.

All decking on the County Road right-of-way must be placed securely, level, and as far off the driving portion of the roadway as possible.

All Skidder/Equipment operations required for the decking are to occur off of the roadway.

Signage must be placed and maintained at all times letting motorists know that there is a logging operation in the area. This must also include necessary/proper warning signs for the decking and loading.

One lane of traffic is to be maintained at all times for traffic to travel without being halted. The skidder/loader and truck operators must stop loading when a vehicle approaches on the roadway.

All loading of trucks and placement or removal of logs by a skidder or other equipment during the decking process must be stopped momentarily as any vehicle passes by the site.

The roadway portion of the right-of-way must be cleared of all debris daily and after each truck is loaded from within the right-of-way.

The roadway and entire right-of-way must be restored to the same condition, at minimum, that the roadway/right-of-way was in before the decking operation, including the removal of all debris.

The Road Commission will invoice the contractor/logger for costs incurred for proper repairs/restoration by Road Commission forces or by a contractor hired by the Road Commission in regard to any damage to the right-of-way, including the roadway, which was not properly repaired/restored by the contractor/logger.

Roll Call Vote: Commissioner Bilski - noy, Commissioner Johnson - aye, Commissioner Milbrath - aye, Commissioner Brisson - aye, and Chairman Carey - aye. The motion carried.
