A motion was made by Chairman Harris and supported by Commissioner Carey that it shall be the policy of the Dickinson County Road Commission that:

- The placement of political signs adjacent to County Roads must be placed a minimum of 14 feet from the outside edge of the shoulder of the roadway.
- 2. Political signs shall not be placed within the "clear vision" areas on intersections that will interfere with safety.
- 3. All political signs must be removed from the county right-of-way within 10 days after the election.
- 4. The Road Commission reserves the right to remove any sign which has not been placed in accordance with this policy.

SUBJECT	Temporary Signs In County Right-Of-Way
ADOPTED ON	October 9, 2012

A motion was made by <u>Commissioner larger</u> and supported by <u>Chairman Harris</u> that it shall be the policy of the Dickinson County Road Commission that:

- 1. The placement of temporary contractor, real estate, retail, or advertisement signs adjacent to County Road must be placed a minimum of 14 feet from the outside edge of the shoulder of the roadway. Temporary retail or advertisement signs are only permitted on the right-of-way adjacent to the owner's property.
- 2. Signs shall not be placed within the "clear vision" areas on intersections that will interfere with safety.
- 3. Signs will be removed from the county right-of-way if the signage has not been placed in accordance with this policy.
- 4. Any signage may be removed from the county right-of-way at the reasonable discretion of the Superintendent of Operations.
