A motion was made by Commissioner Bilski and supported by Commissioner Brisson

On the Local Road System: the costs incurred with the purchase and application of dust control brine, shall be reimbursed to the DCRC by the requesting Township. The Road Commission will partner with the Township by grading and/or watering the roads. The Road Commission will not provide or contract for dust control on the Local Road system without Township participation. The Township will be responsible to provide a list of roads requesting dust control be performed on at the annual Township Projects selection meeting.

On the Local Road System in locations in which a paved surface has been pulverized to aggregate, (if initiated by the Road Commission): the Road Commission will be responsible for the purchase and application of dust control brine, including the grading and/or watering of the roads at the Road Commission's expense, per annual Township request, for a period of up to 5 years after the pulverizing occurred. After 5 years, the Road Commission will partner by grading and/or watering the roads only.

On the Primary Road System: the Road Commission will be responsible for the selection of the Primary Roads to perform dust control on and for the purchase and application of dust control brine, including the grading and/or watering of the roads at the Road Commission's expense and discretion.

Any requests from a Township for

dust control on the Primary Road system that the Road Commission is not in agreement to may be denied or else the Township shall be responsible for the costs associated with the purchase and application of dust control brine including the costs for grading and/or watering of the roads.
