
**SUBJECT**           Township Local Road Contribution Policy

**ADOPTED ON**      February 13, 2002


1. All requests for local road heavy maintenance improvements will be presented to the Road Commission by the appropriate Township Board. The Dickinson County Road Commission will evaluate the roadway improvements and provide the Township with an estimate of improvement costs. Projects will be estimated on a individual project basis.
2. The Road Commission will perform and provide necessary labor, fringes, and equipment for the project and perform the advertising and bidding of any necessary contracted work such as, bituminous surfacing, pulverizing, guardrail, etc.
3. The Road Commission will also provide an amount determined by the appropriation of the County Board. This amount divided by the seven Townships, will be used as a Township match towards the labor, fringes and equipment costs incurred by the Road Commission on the scheduled projects.
4. The Township will be responsible for payment of 100% of the cash material costs, and should a project total cost be over \$100,000.00, the Township will contribute 5% of the labor, fringes and equipment costs towards the project.
5. The Township and/or Road Commission has the authority to delay construction of any project submitted, due to lack of funds or inability to complete the project in a timely fashion.
6. There will be no carry over on any unused match amounts.
