The meeting was called to order by Chairman Carey and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

<u>APPROVE/AMEND AGENDA:</u> Chairman Carey asked if anyone had any amendments to the agenda. Being none, a motion was made by Commissioner Bilski and supported by Commissioner Brisson to approve the agenda. All ayes, and the motion carried.

<u>APPROVE REPORTS:</u> A motion was made by Commissioner Bilski and supported by Commissioner Brisson to approve the Managing Director, Director of Finance, Engineer, Superintendent, and Construction Supervisor reports as presented. All ayes and the motion carried.
