Thank you for your interest in the Dickinson County Road Commission's Engineer position. Dickinson County is in Michigan's beautiful Upper Peninsula. We are a rural county comprised of three cities, seven townships and several villages. Bigger cities such as Green Bay, Marquette and Escanaba are less than an hour and a half away as well as Lake Superior and Lake Michigan. Dickinson County has dozens of lakes and the Menominee River that offers outdoor activities such as fishing, boating, kayaking and white-water rafting. Golfing, Hiking, Off Roding, Camping and popular in the summer as well. Winter-time activities include ice fishing, snowmobiling, skiing, not to mention Giant Pine Mountain that hosts the annual FIS Ski Jumping Continental Cup competition.
