The Dickinson County Road Commission, located in Iron Mountain, Michigan is accepting applications for the position of County Highway Engineer. The Road Commission has jurisdiction of 517 miles of Primary and Local Roads and 24 Bridges.

Under the general direction of the Managing Director, the County Highway Engineer directs and supervises all aspects of design, construction of county roads, bridges and culverts. Prepares or directs preparation of reports, specifications, easement/right of way documents, environmental permitting and plans for street and highway construction. Prepares and submits planning and programming documents. Provides technical direction and reviews work of engineering employees. A broad knowledge of highway design, construction and maintenance is required. Knowledge of local, state and federal highway financing, requirements of the Michigan Department of Transportation regarding project development, construction, testing and documentation is desirable. Work involves contact with townships, county and state officials, private contractors, and the general public.

A Bachelor Degree in Civil Engineering, or closely related field is required. Must be a registered professional in the State of Michigan or have the ability to be licensed within 6 months of hiring. Salary will be commensurate with experience and qualifications.
